**Membership definitions:**

- **Full membership** provides members with unlimited access to the pool, 7 days/week.
- **Weekend membership** provides members with access to the pool Friday through Sunday, Memorial Day, Labor Day and the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.
- **Family Membership** includes 2 adults and official dependents living in the same household (children who are under the full-time care of the adults in the household.) Adults, visiting grandchildren or children who do not live in the household will need to have separate memberships or sign in as guests. Additional adults who are living in the same household are required to purchase a babysitter pass in order to be placed on the membership. Family memberships include immediately family only.
- **Seniors** must be 62 or older by May 26, 2018. ID required.
- **Individuals** must be 13 or older by May 26, 2018. ID required.

*Applications are reviewed by the Pool Board and checked for accuracy. You may be asked to provide proof of dependents and age.*

**RULES AND GUIDELINES:** Management reserves the right to refuse admittance to or eject from the property, any persons failing to comply with any of the pool safety rules and regulations set forth by management and reserves the right to amend the rules as deemed necessary. Due to the severity of an offense, Management may suspend a member or cancel membership without a refund.

1. All members are required to present a current, valid membership card or I.D. when using the facilities.
2. Membership fees and cards are non-refundable and non-transferable. All members are required to follow the policies, procedures and appropriate behaviors for the safety and comfort of all members and guests. Failure to adhere to these policies may subject such member to suspension or loss of membership interest without reimbursement.
3. Parents/guardians are responsible for the behavior of their children/guests.
4. The children’s wading pool is not under lifeguard supervision and is reserved for use by children 5 years old and younger. Children using the wading pool must be supervised by someone 13 years old or older.
5. No cloth or disposable diapers will be allowed in the water. “Swimmies” are required for all children who wear diapers.
6. Persons with infectious, open or bandaged sores may not use the pool.
7. Spitting, spouting of water, clearing of the nose or throat in the pool is prohibited.
8. No glass containers are allowed in the pool grounds.
9. Food and drink may not be carried or consumed within 6 ft. of the pool.
10. Patrons who are visibly dirty must shower before entering the pool.
11. Running or horseplay in the pool area is prohibited.
12. Patrons and guests may not hang on pool lanes or climb on the fences or structures on the pool property.
13. Back flips, cartwheels, jumping backward, or flips, into the pool are not allowed at any time.
14. Deep water restrictions are based upon an individual’s swimming ability and will be established by the Pool Manager, or Lifeguards. The diving well area is for experienced swimmers, no flotation devices are permitted.
15. Air mattresses, inner tubes and similar flotation devices that hinder the lifeguard’s visibility in monitoring all swimmers, are prohibited.
16. No water guns or mermaid tails are allowed in the pools.
17. If the lap lane is in place, it is to be used for swimming laps only.
18. Footballs, frisbees and other objects, which by their material or construction pose a likelihood of injury to others, are prohibited from use in the pool and pool deck areas.
19. The Pool Manager has the prerogative to limit the use of pool toys during periods of higher swimmer volume.
20. Adult swims will be called periodically throughout the day. The pool will be cleared of ALL children under the age of 17 for 10 minutes to permit adult swimming. Children are not permitted to sit on the edge of the pool or are permitted on the sidewalks. NO EXCEPTIONS.
21. Please help us keep our pool clean, please deposit all debris in the trash cans provided on the pool deck and in the bathhouse.
22. Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, scooters, etc. are not permitted to be used on the pool property.
23. Use of tobacco is prohibited within the entire grounds of the pool, and entrance to the pool. This policy covers the smoking of any tobacco product, including electronic cigarettes and the use of smokeless tobacco.
24. Pets are not allowed within the pool area.
25. No profanity is allowed.
26. Use of cell phones, electronic devices, cameras or video recording devices is prohibited in the bath house and ALL dressing areas and restrooms. Use of such devices in these areas will result in a termination of membership and expulsion from the property.
27. Radios and other media devices are not permitted on the pool deck within 12 ft. of the water surface. Such equipment may be used in other pool areas if not disturbing other patrons.
28. Adult members may use the grilling area on a “first come, first served basis” as long as the pavilion and grill have not been reserved for a party. Please check with the Pool Manager before using. A \$5 fee applies for standard use. Users must clean the grill and area after use. Children are not allowed in the grilling area.
29. The Pool Manager or Assistant Manager may close the pool or a section of the pool at any time due to operational difficulties, inclement weather, staffing considerations or at their professional discretion to resolve situations that they deem might pose a risk to patrons.
30. Bouquet Park Pool Management and Board are not responsible for personal property that is lost, damaged or stolen within the pool facility or parking lot. We will hold “found” articles for two weeks before disposing of them.
31. Management and the guards on duty management reserve the right to amend the rules as deemed necessary and at their discretion in order to maintain the safety of the patrons and the facility.
32. We photograph various activities for promotional use. Please let the photographer know if you do not wish to be included in pictures.
33. We are a family-friendly facility; please dress appropriately. Proper swimsuits must be worn in pool areas. No jeans, pants, sweat pants or frayed material will be allowed in the pool.
34. Community members may enter the pool on the 3rd Friday of the month without a member. Community members and guests may purchase a day pass: adults are \$10.00, children 2-17 and adults 62 and older are \$5.00.
35. We do not provide accident insurance for injuries sustained during Bouquet Park activities. Members and community participants participate in programs and use the facility at their own risk, and are encouraged to have personal medical insurance coverage.
36. Persons deemed under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs or behaving in a combative way will not be permitted in the pool or pool grounds and will be asked to leave. This may be determined at the discretion of the Pool Manager, Lifeguard or Pool Board Member.
37. Lifeguards, managers, front desk or snack bar attendants on duty are not permitted to sign in non-members as their guests.
38. Socializing with the Lifeguards or staff while on duty is prohibited.
39. All means of transportation must be parked in designated areas. This includes automobiles, bicycles, and motorcycles.
40. Children using noodles, water wings, or life preserving swimwear must be accompanied into the pool with an adult. Lifeguards may determine a child to be required to have adult supervision in the pool.
41. Diving is only permitted in designated areas. Lifeguards may limit diving if the pool is busy.
